Friday, December 1st is Phase 1 of All-Region Band auditions! These first rounds of auditions at Dekaney HS will be for specific instruments only and those who place at the top of their audition groups will advance to Phase 2 on Saturday, December 2nd.

Phase 1 auditions include the following instruments:

Flute
Bb Clarinet
Alto Sax
Trumpet
Percussion

Phase 2 auditions include the following instruments:

(Those students who are chose from the above list on Friday evening to advance to Phase 2)

Piccolo
Oboe
Bassoon
Low Clarinet
Low Saxes
French Horn
Trombones
Euphoniums
Tubas

Phase 1

Those students auditioning on Friday evening will depart WHS at 5pm and will warm up and check in to their rooms. Auditions will begin at 5:45pm and will last as long as it takes for each respective room to finish. Because rooms will likely end at drastically different times **it is important that you arrange transportation home from Dekaney HS for when you are done with your individual audition.** Should you advance to Phase 2 (Saturday, December 2nd) a band director will contact you after results are posted that evening or you can stay and wait to find out.

Phase 2

Those students who advance to Phase 2 or are doing their first round of auditions that day, we will meet at WHS at 11am to gather equipment and go over procedures. We will depart WHS at 11:45am by bus and go to Dekaney HS. Warm up and check in will begin at 12:15pm and auditions will begin at 1pm. Each student will finish their respective auditions at different times so **it is important that each person arrange transportation back home from Dekaney HS**. Results will be communicated by a band director after they are posted or you can feel free to stay and see the results posted.
